In this workshop we will cover all the topics for the Cisco DevNet Associate exam: introduction to software development and design, understanding and using APIs, application deployment and security, infrastructure automation, network fundamentals and Cisco platforms such as Cisco Meraki, Cisco SD-WAN, Cisco DNA Center, Cisco NSO, Cisco UCS, Cisco Webex Teams, etc. This is an introductory workshop so we will cover all these topics from a beginner's perspective. For the hands-on activities basic knowledge of Python is helpful but not mandatory.



All attendees are encouraged to bring their own laptops to work on. You will only need an Internet connection and a browser.
